ATTORNEY

Attorney in Private Practice

The County Board of Education may appoint an attorney in private practice as an employee or independent contractor, or use an administrative advisor as defined by Education Code Section 35041 for whatever purpose the County Board deem appropriate and fix and pay such attorney according to the contract.

As provided in Education Code Section 35041.5, the County Board and the County Superintendent shall appoint the same legal counsel.
