Bylaws of the Board

RESIGNATION

A County Board member who wishes to resign shall file a written resignation with the County Superintendent of Schools. The resigning County Board member shall also give a copy of the written resignation to the Board secretary. The resignation shall become effective when filed, except when a deferred effective date is specified in the resignation.

A County Board member may not defer the effective date of his/her resignation for more than sixty (60) days after filing. A written resignation, whether specifying a deferred effective date or otherwise, shall be irrevocable once filed.

A County Board member who tenders his/her resignation with a deferred effective date shall continue to exercise all the powers of his/her office, except those involving the provisional appointment of his/her successor, until the effective date of the resignation.
