Bylaws of the Board

LEGAL PROTECTION

The County Board of Education directs the County Superintendent of Schools to make provision in the budget for adequate liability insurance necessary to protect the corporate body of the County Board, its members, its officers and its employees from any judgment as a result of suits alleging their liability in such matters as equal opportunity, improper discharge of employees, negligence, or other act resulting in accidental injury to any person or property damage in or out of the county office owned facilities while the above-named insured are acting in the discharge of their duties within the scope of their offices or employment and/or under the direction of the County Board.
