## INTERDISTRICT ATTENDANCE APPEALS BEFORE THE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION

## **HEARING PROCESS \***

- I. <u>Opening</u> by the County Board of Education President. He/she explains the procedures to be followed during the hearing:
  - A. The persons who may be heard:
    - 1. Parent(s) or guardian(s)
    - 2. Other representatives of the student, i.e., legal counsel
    - 3. Representatives of involved districts
  - B. After the hearing, the County Board will deliberate and come to a decision.
  - C. The County Board's determination will be limited to one of the following:
    - 1. Remand case back to the district
    - 2. Deny the appeal
    - 3. Approve the appeal
- II. <u>Presentation</u> of the case by the Assistant Superintendent, Educational Services, or designee.
- III. <u>Presentation</u> of the case by the parent/guardian of the student.
- IV. <u>Questioning</u> of parent/guardian:
  - A. By County Office of Education staff members
  - B. By representative of affected school districts
  - C. By County Board members
- V. <u>Presentation</u> by representatives of the district of residence.
- VI. <u>Questioning</u> of representatives of the district of residence:
  - A. By County Office of Education staff members
  - B. By parent/guardian
  - C. By representatives of district of proposed attendance
  - D. By County Board members
- VII. <u>Presentation</u> by representatives of the district of proposed attendance.
- VIII. <u>Questioning</u> of representatives of the district of proposed attendance:
  - A. By County Office of Education staff members
  - B. By parent/guardian
  - C. By representatives of district of residence
  - D. By County Board members
- IX. <u>Recommendation</u> by Assistant Superintendent, Educational Services or designee.
- X. <u>Deliberation and Decision</u> by County Board of Education. Determination will be limited to the following:
  - A. Remand case back to district
  - B. Deny appeal
  - C. Approve appeal
- \* If persons are not present to address an item in its order, then the appeal will move to the next item
