

ADMINISTRATIVE LEEWAY IN ABSENCE OF GOVERNING BOARD POLICY

With regard to matters within the jurisdiction of the County Board of Education, the County Superintendent of Schools is empowered to act in cases where action must be taken and where the County Board of Education has not provided guidelines for administrative action. The County Board shall review the County Superintendent's decision at the next regular County Board meeting.

It shall be the duty of the County Superintendent to keep the County Board president apprised of any action taken in an emergency as soon as practicable after its occurrence and when possible prior to the County Board's next regular meeting. When appropriate, the president shall inform the County Board of such occurrences before its next regular meeting. If the action necessitates change to current policy, the County Superintendent shall make the necessary recommendations to the County Board.
