Business and Non-Instructional Operations

SALE AND DISPOSAL OF BOOKS, EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES (PERSONAL PROPERTY)

Title to all property purchased by the County Superintendent from the County School Service Fund is in the Office of the County Superintendent. (Education Code 1605)

All items declared surplus valued at over five hundred dollars (\$500) shall be by approval of the County Board of Education.

The County Superintendent of Schools recognizes that the County Office of Education may own personal property which is unusable, obsolete or no longer needed. The County Superintendent or designee shall arrange for the sale or disposal of district personal property in accordance with County Office of Education policy and the requirements of state law.
