COMPREHENSIVE SAFETY PLAN

Development of Safety Plan

The County Superintendent may delegate the responsibility for writing and developing a school safety plan to a school safety planning committee. This committee shall be composed of the following members: (Education Code 35294.1)

- 1. The principal or designee
- 2. One teacher
- 3. One parent/guardian whose child attends the school
- 4. One classified employee
- 5. Other members, if desired

Elements of the Safety Plan

The safety plan shall include, but not be limited to: (Education Code 35294.2)

- An assessment of the current status of school crime committed on County Office facilities and at school-related functions.
- 2. Appropriate strategies and programs that will provide or maintain a high level of school safety and address the school's procedures for complying with existing laws related to school safety, which shall include the development of all of the following:
 - a. Child abuse reporting procedures consistent with Penal Code 11164.
 - b. Routine and emergency disaster procedures.
 - c. Policies pursuant to Education Code 48915 and other school-designated serious acts which would lead to suspension, expulsion or mandatory expulsion recommendations.
 - d. Procedures to notify teachers of dangerous students pursuant to Education Code 49079.
 - e. A sexual harassment policy pursuant to Education Code 212.6.
 - f. A dress code prohibiting students from wearing "gang-related apparel."
 - g. Procedures for safe ingress and egress of students, parents/ guardians and employees.
 - h. A safe and orderly environment conducive to learning at the school.
 - i. The rules and procedures on school discipline adopted pursuant to Education Code 35291 and 35291.5.

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
