Administration CONCEPTS AND ROLES

The County Office of Education shall promote the creation of the best possible educational program and shall maintain an environment conducive to learning. The County Superintendent shall provide the vision and educational leadership in this effort and shall give top priority to meeting the needs of all students and helping teachers raise academic achievement.

The County Superintendent or designee shall develop decision-making processes that are responsive to the school community, the specific needs of individual students, and school districts within the county. He/she shall provide the means by which staff, students, and parents/guardians at each school and within each program may participate in decisions relating to school improvement. The administration shall provide professional advice to the County Board of Education.

Within the parameters of law, the County Superintendent may employ administrative and supervisory personnel to assist in the effective management of the County Office of Education. All schools, departments, and programs shall form a single administrative system organized so that appropriate decision-making may take place at various levels in accordance with County Board and Superintendent policies and administrative regulations.

The County Superintendent desires to give all administrators the authority needed to carry out their assigned responsibilities. The County Superintendent shall clearly state what is expected of all administrators and shall evaluate how well those expectations have been met.
