Objective: Increasing Student Achievement

Goal #1: Improve curricular and instructional practice, leading to increased student engagement and achievement Goal #2: Provide and implement targeted professional development in the areas of CCSS, CCSS aligned curriculum and effective instructional strategies.

Rationale. What were the findings from the analysis of this data?

Increasing student engagement in the classroom increases student achievement and decreases student off task behavior. Students attending this program struggle academically and behaviourally and will benefit from research based instructional practices implemented with fidelity by all staff.

Students struggle earning appropriate credits per quarter/semester. Awarding of credits per class is not aligned.

There is not a current college and career

How will the school evaluate the progress of this goal?

- Classroom Implementation of standards based rigorous curriculum
- Classroom observations of research based instructional practices
- Classroom observations of increased student engagement
- Reduction in office referrals
- Semester analysis of individual students achievement data and quarterly monitoring of credit recovery and grades
- Review/refine the schoolwide action plan, SPSA twice yearly fostering the cycle of continuous improvement

- Lack of implementation of social emotional support system for students

Rationale. What were the findings from the analysis of this data?

Students attending the program struggle behaviourally. No current system of support has been in place that was consistent, implemented with fidelity and based upon addressing student needs.

Classroom expectations that were not implemented with fidelity increased student off task behavior and office referrals.

How will the school evaluate the progress of this goal?

- Review office referrals, discipline incidents in Aeries
- Levels of academic engagement in classroom
- > Reduction in suspensions
- Monthly increase in attendance rates
- Review/refine the schoolwide action plan, SPSA twice yearly fostering the cycle of continuous improvement
- > Student Surveys

STRATEGY: The school will create a trusting, emotionally safe arena where students are supported both academically and socially emotionally by all staff.

Rationale. What were the findings from the analysis of this data?

Few parents are involved in the decision making of the school. Parents are contacted frequently by telephone and feel confident contacting the school by phone to speak with staff yet few attend meetings at the site.

In the past, there were community partners involved at the school however their participation was not consistent, equitable nor in line with school vision/mission.

How will the school evaluate the progress of this goal?

- Attendance notes/Intervention notes in Aeries indicating contact by phone
- Track the increase in opportunities and support provided by community members
- Increased number of parent events that are purposeful
- Review/refine the schoolwide action plan, SPSA twice yearly fostering the cycle of continuous improvement

STRATEGY: The school will involve community members that provide direct, consistent support to students. The school will increase purposeful opportunities for parents to participate in supporting student success.
