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DESCRIPTION

- Performance Tasks allow students to engage with mathematical concepts in deep, meaningful ways. These low-threshold, high-ceiling problems can be approached by students with minimal background but still lead to concepts rooted in advanced mathematics. In this series, time will be spent exploring math performance tasks, scoring them, and developing re-engagement lessons to address mathematical misconceptions.
- Participants will be expected to devote some class time in between sessions to administer a performance task and re-engagement lesson to their students.
- Time will also be spent exploring a variety of fun, engaging math activities that can be used on a distance-learning platform.
